Transport & Parking

There will be no parking available in the pub car park or outside the pub (unless you arrive in a vintage car, in which case you will be able to show it off on the lay-by opposite the pub). All other car parking will be in a couple of fields about 300m from the pub and you will be directed by signs and parking attendants (Don't worry, there will be plenty of tractors around to pull you out if you get stuck!). The road in front of the pub will be closed to through traffic on Saturday and Sunday.

We want to encourage as many people to cycle to the festival as possible and there will be a secure bicycle lock up area in the new bike shed behind the pub, but you could also lock your bikes to the fencing around the building site.

You will also be able to camp in the car park meadow (this is the car park if you are coming from the Great Leighs end of Littley Green Road). There is no camping in the car park where the ploughing is taking place. Be aware that no facilities will be available (apart from the toilet trailer in the pub car park), and you camp at your own risk. **Strictly no fires to be lit in the camping field and please do not leave any litter.** (These fields have been kindly lent to us over the weekend.)

The car parks must be fully vacated by 6pm on Sunday or your vehicle will be removed.

Please feel free to bring your own chairs to the festival.

Please respect our neighbours when you make your way back to your car.

Taxis

People found it difficult to arrange taxis last year, especially last minute, as it is the V Festival weekend. Bars & Festival Glasses

48 real ales will be available in the Beer Tents in the front garden (there will be two bars – The Old Bob Bar & The Huffer Bar). Local Felstar English Wines and soft drinks will be available from The Huffer Bar.

12 real ciders and perries will be available from the Cellar Bar situated through the gate in the front garden. This is also the location for the reserve real ales list – please check for availability.

The ciders, perries and reserve real ales will also be available from the Main Bar situated inside the pub. Otherwise, the Main Bar will function as normal.

You will need to purchase a commemorative charity glass (from the gazebo situated at the front of the pub) in order to buy beer or cider from any of the bars.

You will also need to hire a wine glass to buy wine from the beer tent.

A festival glass costs £3 and will be yours for the duration of the festival (it can be returned to the gazebo for a £2 refund if you don't want to take it home with you). A wine glass costs £1 (it must be returned to the gazebo for a 50p refund).
